

**Notice of Public Hearing**  
**Community Development Block Grant Application**

The City Council of the City of Rawlins is seeking public input and public comments on an Economic Development Infrastructure Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) application. The City of Rawlins is interested in obtaining funding for the **Adaptive Reuse of the Historic Guards' Quarters located at the Wyoming Frontier Prison in Rawlins, Wyoming**. The grant request contemplated will not exceed Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00).

Other possible CDBG applications may be considered provided they support at least one of three National Objectives:

1. Benefit to low and moderated income persons.
2. Aid in the prevention or elimination of slums or blight.
3. Activities designed to meet community development needs having a particular urgency.

Cedar Street, Rawlins, Wyoming, to solicit input from the citizenry, take public testimony and solicit public opinion, inform the public and gather information for submission of a Wyoming Business Council Economic Development Infrastructure CDBG Grant.** Accommodations will be made for handicapped and non-English speaking individuals who wish to attend the Public Hearing.
