To the Rawlins community:

Over the course of the last several weeks the United States, State of Wyoming and the City of Rawlins have been working diligently to deal with the COVID-19 crisis that is sweeping the world. Throughout this time Governor Mark Gordon issued a series of Executive Orders detailing restrictions, closures and guidance to avoid the spread of this virus. These orders required the closing of certain businesses, prohibit gatherings of certain types, and require social distancing.

The City of Rawlins is committed to following the orders passed down by the State of Wyoming and State Health Officer but are understanding of the citizen's need to continue to find outlets for and activities to continue to enjoy their life in acceptable ways. Guidance detailed below is based on these orders on ways for the citizen's to stay healthy and maintain an active lifestyle.

The Rochelle Ranch Golf Course is scheduled to open on April 25, 2020, under restricted access and strict rules.

The Outdoor Shooting Range is scheduled to open May 1, 2020, under restricted access and strict rules.

The City of Rawlins maintains several park and green space areas along with walking trails throughout the City for the benefit of our citizens. Open areas within these parks are not shut down during this health order. During this time the City will rope off playground equipment and ask citizens to not utilize the equipment to ensure no spread of germs.

The City of Rawlins asks when enjoying the outdoors that individuals respect and follow the orders of the State by:

- Maintaining 6 feet social distancing from other individuals, excluding immediate family members.
- Ensure no gatherings of more than 10 people in a single room or a single confined space at the same time.
- Adhere to strict hygiene practices, including but not limited to, hand-washing, use of sanitizer, and other safety practices.

Your elected officials and city staff continue to monitor the situation and any new circumstances will be communicated to our citizens as information becomes available.
