REGISTER TO VOTE

- Didn't vote in the General 2022 Election? **You may need to register or re-register.**
- Register now with any municipal clerk or the county clerk and avoid wait times on Election Day.
- Can also register at the polls on Election Day.

ALREADY REGISTERED

- **Want to change your political party?** ****NEW** - You must do so in person by May 15 with any municipal clerk or the county clerk! Not allowed May 16 through Primary Election Day.**
- Can change your name or address at any time.

UNINCORPORATED VOTERS

- Voters living outside of a town **not** affiliated with a major party in the Primary, Rep or Dem, will not have a ballot. See the party change deadline above.
